ORDER:-

In the G.O. first read above, guidelines for admission of students in B.Ed., course in Government / Government Aided / Self Financing Colleges of Education for the year 2014-15 were issued.

2. In the G.O. second read above, orders have been issued entrusting the work relating to Single Window counselling for admission of students to B.Ed., & M.Ed., Degree courses in Government and Government Aided Colleges of Education to the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University from the academic year 2014-15.

3. The Vice-Chancellor, Tamilnadu Teachers Education University in his letters third read above has stated that consequent to the entrustment of the work relating to Single Window Counselling for admission of students to both B.Ed. and M.Ed. Degree Courses in Government and Government Aided Colleges of Education from the academic year 2014-2015 to Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, the University is taking consistent steps to execute the work relating to Single Window Counselling for admission of students to the above said degree programmes. He has informed that the admission of students to M.Ed. Degree Course is usually made as per the regulations of the University and it was not done through Single Window Counselling, previously. There are about 797 M.Ed. seats in

all the Government and Government Aided Colleges put together. He has desired to include the admission of students to M.Ed. Degree Programmes that's being offered in the Government and Government Aided Colleges through Single Window Counselling by following the Regulations of the University. He has sent the guidelines for admission of students to M.Ed., Course to Government / Government Aided Colleges of Education through Single Window System for the year 2014-15 by the Tamilnadu Teachers Education University and requested the Government to approve the same.

4. The Government have examined the above proposal of Vice-Chancellor, Tamil Nadu Teacher Education University and decided to accept the same. Accordingly the Government approve the guidelines for admission of students to M.Ed. Degree course in Government / Government Aided College of Education through Single Window Counselling for the year 2014-15 by the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University. as annexed to this order.

GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION TO M.Ed., COURSE FOR THE YEAR 2014-2015

(Government / Government Aided Colleges of Education)

I. Eligibility and Educational Qualification

- (i) The candidates should have undergone 10+2+3 (15) or 11+1+3 (15) pattern of study and passed the qualifying examination conducted by the respective State Board or CBSE or any other recognized Universities and a minimum of 50% marks both in Theory and Practicals separately in B.Ed., degree irrespective of the community.
- (ii) The candidates should have undergone 10+2+4 Year Integrated B.Ed., or 11+1+4 Year Integrated B.Ed., with a minimum of 50% marks both in Theory and Practicals separately irrespective of the community.
- (iii) Candidates who have passed the U.G. or P.G. degree in Open University System without qualifying in 11 years SSLC examination and 1 year of Pre-University Course (P.U.C) examination or 10+2 pattern of School Education examination will not be considered for admission.
- (iv) Candidates who have passed under Dual Degree, Later entry and Additional Degree Programme with less than three years duration are not eligible for admission.
- (v) The percentage of marks in B.Ed degree is calculated by adding the marks obtained in Theory and Practicals.

II. Reservation of Seats

1. Reservation of seats for candidates belonging to BC, MBC/DNC, SC and ST communities will be made as per the rules and regulations of the Government.
 - (i) In the 18% for Scheduled Castes (SC), 3% of seats will be offered to Arunthathiyars (within the seats for SC)
 - (ii) Scheduled Tribes (ST) 1%
 - (iii) Most Backward Classes (MBC) and Denotified Communities (DNC) 20%
 - (iv) Backward Classes (BC) 30%, within this 3.5% for Muslims
 - (v) Open Competition (OC) 31%

2. Admission into every College of Education shall be made strictly by following the rule of reservation as per law in force including the Management quota seats of Non-Minority Aided Colleges.
3. For the wards of Ex-Servicemen of Tamil Nadu origin, one seat will be reserved in each College of Education.
4. 3% of the sanctioned strength will be reserved for Physically and Visually Challenged students in each College of Education. One seat is exclusively allotted for Visually Challenged candidates in two IASEs and five Government Colleges of Education.

III. Selection and Admission Procedure under Single Window System

a) Allocation of seats in the Colleges of Education.

Seats in the College of Education are grouped into the following categories.

- (i) Seats in Government Colleges of Education (100% of seats Government quota)
- (ii) Seats in Government Aided Colleges of Education (50% of seats in Aided Minority Colleges and 90% of seats in Non-minority Aided Colleges as Government quota)
- (iii) The number of seats available in each institution will be notified at the Counselling Centre.

b) Method of Application

- (i) Accurate information about the percentage of marks is essential. The candidate is totally responsible for any incorrect information and incorrect percentage of marks.
- (ii) Candidates are advised to take a Xerox copy of the coding sheet and fill up all the information correctly before filling the original coding sheet.
- (iii) A candidate needs to submit only one application for M.Ed., course seeking admission to Government and Government Aided Colleges of Education. The cost of application is Rs.300/-. In the case of SC/ST candidates the cost of application is Rs.175/- on production of attested xerox copy of the Community Certificate. The cost of application must be paid either in cash or in the form of Demand Draft from any Nationalised Bank / Scheduled Bank in favour of "The Secretary, Tamil Nadu B.Ed/M.Ed Admission Committee, Chennai." Payable at Chennai.

c) Last Date

1. (i) Last date for uploading the application will be notified in the advertisement.

(ii) Application not received on or before the due date, not in the prescribed form, not correctly filled up or do not otherwise fulfil the terms of the instructions will be considered defective and are liable for rejection without any notice.
2. (i) The candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu only will be considered for communal reservation. Candidates seeking admission against SC/SC (Arunthathiyars) / ST/MBC/DNC/BC Muslim / BC others quota should obtain the Certificate of Social Status in the prescribed permanent Community Certificate / Card of Tamil Nadu and that should be produced at the time of counselling.

(ii) The ST candidates should obtain the Community Certificates only from the Revenue Divisional Officer (RDO) of their native place or Collector of their District.
3. Candidates have to send the filled in applications by online along with the community certificate as 'loose sheet' to "The Secretary", Tamilnadu B.Ed/M.Ed Admission Committee, Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, Lady Willingdon College Campus, Kamarajar Salai, Triplicane, Chennai 600 005. (For details refer the advertisement)

d) Selection and Counselling

1. The Selection of candidates will be on the basis of the marks secured in B.Ed and other qualifying examinations.
2. (i) Candidates will be called for counselling in the order of their rank. Based on the mark and communal reservations, allotment will be made to the college. Candidates other than SC/ST have to submit a Demand Draft for Rs.2000/- and Rs.1000/- in case of Tamil Nadu SC/ST candidates as "Initial Payment" drawn in favour of "The Secretary, Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University B.Ed/M.Ed., Admission Committee, Chennai", at the time of counselling.

(ii) Candidates will have to produce all the original certificates and fee receipt at the time of counselling for verification and admission or at any other time as required by the authorities. Selection will not be made if they do not produce the relevant documents at the time of counselling for verification.

- (iii) Once the candidate is allotted a seat, the amount of Rs.2000/- for other communities and Rs.1000/- in the case of SC/ST (in Tamil Nadu) already paid as "Initial Payment" at the time of counselling will be adjusted towards the tuition fees that has to be paid to the respective allotted college.
3. (i) The date, time and venue of the counselling will be intimated to the individual candidates by post and or through the press / media. No request for change of date / time of counselling is permissible.
- (ii) Candidate will not be considered for selection if he / she fails to (i) report at the specified date and time for counselling, (ii) produce all the original certificates at the time of counselling for verification.
- (iii) The candidates have to join the colleges to which they are allotted within the time notified in the admission order, failing which, the seats will be deemed to have fallen vacant. No request for reconsideration of admission thereafter shall be entertained.
4. The provisionally selected candidates in the counselling will be directed to report for admission to the institution specified in the admission order. Candidate has to report within the specified date with all the certificates in original and must be ready to remit the fees as directed in the allotted college.
5. The provisional selection of the candidate will be cancelled, if he/she fails to (i) report within the specified time limit at the allotted college, (ii) produce original certificates, (iii) remit the fees required to be paid at the college, and such allotted seat will be filled by other candidates as per ranking list.

IV. Rank Listing

1. (i) The percentage of marks obtained by the candidate in B.Ed, Theory and Practical put together will be taken as the base mark for ranking.
- (ii) Selection of the elective subject is the choice of the candidate based on the subjects / facilities available in the allotted colleges.

V. Important Instructions

All the entries in the application form and coding sheet should be entered / written legibly by the candidate. The candidate should ensure that all the information including the marks in the qualifying examination furnished by him/her in the application form and the coding sheet are correct. Any incorrect details furnished in the application form and coding sheet will result in the candidate's selection being cancelled.

VI. Physical Fitness Certificate

Candidates selected will have to submit a Certificate of Physical Fitness obtained from a Government Civil Surgeon / Civil Assistant Surgeon within the specified date. Otherwise his / her selection will be cancelled.
